NOTICE OF RACE 2019

Organizing Authority:

Federazione Italiana Vela (FIV), Lega Navale Pisa, Yachting Club Montecatini a.s.d, Associazione Nazionale Classe SB20

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 The prescriptions of F.I.V. (Italian Sailing Federation) will be applied.

1.3 The Tracker installation will be mandatory, the same will be provided by the organization during the various registration operations. It will be mandatory to have the device turned on during the races that will take place during the three days

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is allowed as by SB20 Class Rules.

2.2 Boats may be requested to display event flags and, on the hull, event advertising stickers as provided by the organizing authority in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.3

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to SB20 Class boats as defined by SB20 Class Rules.

3.2 Owners and Helmsmen must be either nationals or residents, and members of the National SB20 Class Association of the country they represent.

3.3 All Italian sailors must be current members of the F.I.V., foreign sailors must be in order with the rules of their National Authority

3.4 Competitors shall register in advance within June 23th 2019 online: <http://www.sb20italianchampionship.com/>.

3.5 An extra fee of € 100,00 will be charged for late entries and payments.

3.6 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000,00 per event. The applicant will provide copy of the insurance contract.

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee will be euro 230,00 each boat; to be paid on the IBAN IT62Y0800370460000000105917 of YCMontecatini.

4.2 Entry fee includes launching/hauling, storage of boats and trailers from May 30th to August 31st in the Marinanova base (www.marinanova.it)

4.3 All entry fees are payable with the inscription.

5. SCHEDULE

04 July, registration, crew weight, launching, delivery tracker.

05 July, briefing h 9:00; h 13:00 reces

06 July, h 12:00 races; h 18:00 aperitive

07 July, ore 12:00 races; h 18:00 pricegiving party.

5.2 The warning signal for the first race on July 5th will be at 1.00 pm.

5.3 No more than 4 trials will be held per day.

5.4 On 7th July no warning signal will be given after 15.30. REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT

6.1 At registration, boats shall present:

- proof of current marine liability insurance coverage;
- crew list;
- FIV membership card for all Italian sailors; • proof of SB20 membership for the owner
- Advertising license (only for Italian boats).

6.2 All competitors will be weighed during registration. Competitors must show a ID card valid for foreign travel at the crew weight check.

6.3 All boats will be subject to random inspection at any time during the regatta.

6.4 There is no stamping of the sails.



7. SAILING

The sailing instructions will be available during Skipper Meeting.

8. VENUE

8.1 Races area in front of Marina di Pisa

8.2 Championship base: Marinanova (www.marinanova.it)

9. THE COURSE

Upwind downwind, two turns.

10. PENALTY SYSTEMS

10. The Race Committee may also announce the numbers of the boats that have broken starting rules via VHF.

11. SCORING

11.1 The scoring system applied will be as follows: The Low Point System defined in RRS Appendix A.

11.2 Ten races are scheduled. A minimum of four completed races are required to constitute a championship.

11.3 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been sailed, the score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.

12. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

12 Boats shall be afloat by 10:00am on 5 July; they shall not be hauled out for all event period except and with written clearance of the RC.

13. OTHER PROHIBITED ACTIONS

13.1 Underwater breathing apparatus, plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used during the regatta. The hull may be cleaned at any time by swimming or keelhauling using ropes or cloth.

13.2 Boats shall not be moored other than in their assigned places.

14. PRIZES

14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 5.

14.2 The Italian crew with the best scoring will be the 2019 National Champion

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

15.1 Competitors give absolute right and permission to organisation authority to use, publish, broadcast or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sound recorded during the event of persons and boats free of any charge.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

16.1 Competitors participate during all the event at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

16.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
